RE: FOIPOP Application Number 2012-574

This letter is further to your application under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, for Department of Environment – Yarmouth Office. Copy of Inspector Heather MacPherson's on site inspection report done on Robert Huby's mink farm in August 2012.

Access to this information has been partially granted. Information falling under the following exemption provision has been severed from the records in accordance with subsection 5(2) of the *Act*. The text which has been severed from the documents contains personal identifiable information which, if released, would be considered an unreasonable invasion of privacy (s.20), and information which would reveal advice, recommendations developed by or for a public body or a minister (s.14).

s.14 Advice to the Public Body or Minister

(1) The head of a public body may refuse to disclose to an applicant information that would reveal advice, recommendations or draft regulations developed by or for a public body or a minister.

s.20 Personal information

(1) The head of a public body shall refuse to disclose personal information to an applicant if the disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's personal privacy.

You have the right to ask, within 60 days of being notified of this decision, for a review of this decision by a Review Officer. If you wish to ask for a review, you may do so on Form 7, a copy of which is attached. This completed form should then be sent to: Review Officer, PO Box 181, Halifax, NS, B3J 2M4.

Call back received from Farm Manager reports the follow: nipple drinkers have been installed, gutters have been installed on pens and underground piping connected to the gutters has been installed with draining from gutters directed towards the front of farm rather than toward the back.

Saucering between the pens has been initiated but is not completed. The existing back ditching has been cleaned out fully now and relays that surface water runoff has been greatly reduced to the ditching (this was noted during a few rain events that have occurred) that it has made a big difference with managing surface water flow between the pens.

Follow up inspection discussed and Inspector will contact

towards end of October to follow up.





In the photo bucket link you will find a video taken starting at the lake, walking up the hill to the mink farm aprx 66M when calculated using wikimapia. A collection of photos has also been added to the site starting at the lake with visible mink feces floating upon arrival to site along with the disaster left behind by the trail of feces runing down the hill.

Pay close attention towards the end of the video where a visible ditch has been cut into the embankment allowing the run off to EASALY make it's way down to the lake.

We, the residence of this lake want to know what actions will or will not be taken to address this problem. It has become a great concern to us as we have watched our lake deteriorate from prestine clear source fed water with 13+ feet of visibility to a stinky, brown mess with 1.5feet visibility. These major changes have been noted as starting no later than 2 years ago.


